2018/2019 Dues

Several members had already given me dues payments for next year at the higher rate before our Board voted to decrease our Branch share of the dues from \$20 to \$15 to offset part of National's \$10 increase. Refunds of \$5 each have been mailed to these members.

The email notice from AAUW National about next year's dues should be arriving in your email box soon. The notice will be for a total of \$87 for next year. That includes an increase for National to \$59, the same for State at \$13, and the reduction to \$15 for Oshkosh.

You can pay your dues online through an easy-to-use link in your e-mailed renewal notice. Of course, it will still be fine to write a check to AAUW for your dues and give it to me or mail it to me, and I will transfer the state/national amount for you and retain the amount for our branch.
